Admissions Information 2019/20

Fees

Full Boarding fees for the academic year 2019/20 are £37,500.

Fees are payable on a twice yearly basis in advance.

Initial invoices are issued with enrolment papers and subsequent invoices are issued each December and June.

The registration fee of £150 and deposit of £10,000 (refundable when the student leaves the School), will need to be paid to confirm the place.
